




LIEUTENANT HARRY QUESTER and his best friend --

Tony, an eager, free spirit, wants the adventure of serving in a naval force commanded by his father, VICE ADMIRAL THOMAS ZEE.




Tony is assigned to "The River" in patrol boats whose mission is to prevent Viet Cong supplies from moving from Cambodia to Saigon.
